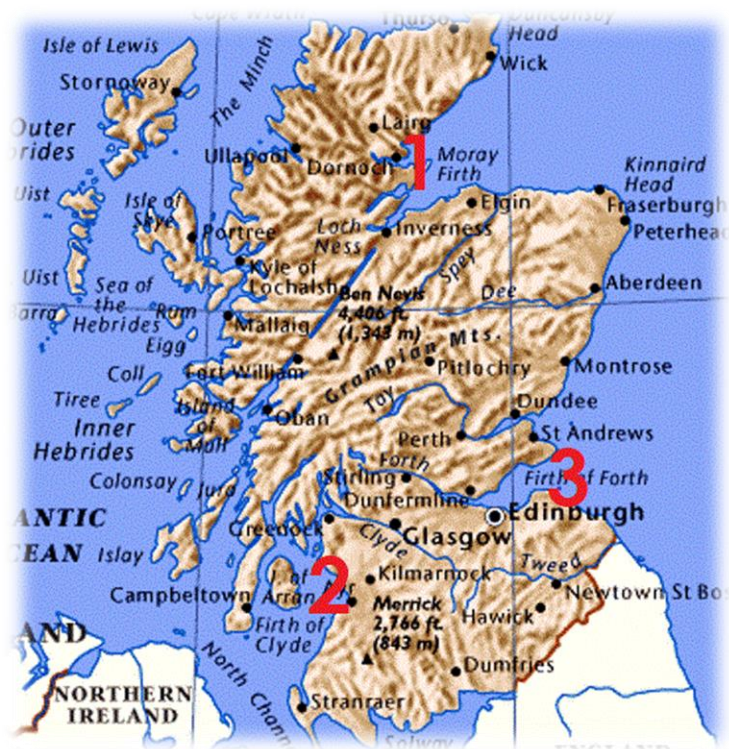

DETAILED ITINERARY

SATURDAY 5/9/26 - TRAVEL TO DORNOCH IN THE SCOTTISH HIGHLANDS

Travel to Dornoch. Early arrivals may want an afternoon round over the Struie Course? In the evening, we will meet for a happy hour followed by dinner in our Highlands base, the Dornoch Station Hotel!

Hotel: Dornoch Station Hotel

SUNDAY 6/9/26 – PLAY ROYAL DORNOCH

This course has cast a spell over some of the greatest golfers who have ever lived. Its isolation did not deter the likes of Vardon, Taylor and Braid from visiting the links in the earlier part of this century. In more recent times Tom Watson, Ben Crenshaw, Greg Norman and Nick Faldo have all embarked on what is an irresistible pilgrimage. Tom Watson described his experiences of Royal Dornoch as 'the most fun I have had playing golf in my life'.



Firstly, there's the location and setting. It is miles away from anywhere and has been called 'The Star of the North'. It is bordered by The Dornoch Firth and for its entire length by a beautiful sweep of pristine white sand. Mountains and hills fill the horizon creating the illusion that you are playing on a stage. In spring and early summer much of the links turn from green to gold with the gorse as much a backdrop as a hazard. It is thought that golf was played on the links as early as the 16th century. Officially, the course is the third oldest course in the world. The quality of the golf is another reason for visiting. It is widely regarded as the most natural links course in the world and blends perfectly into its landscape. It is golf in its purest form with natural hazards & is surely one to visit for the historian and the player.

MONDAY 7/9/26 – PLAY BRORA

Brora is the most northerly memorial to James Braid in his native Scotland. Brora is also the headquarters of the James Braid Golfing Society. Given 194 acres of links land to work on, what in 1923 was entitled "Braid's Plan" is hardly altered. Here you will enjoy the bent grass and beach sand, burn water and gorse in glorious yellow bloom. There is even a railway which comes into play from #10.



With the exception of the short sixth, the outward nine holes follow the contour of Kintradwell Bay in the foreground, with a backdrop of the Sutherland foothills from Ben Bhraggie to the west, away to the Ord of Caithness in the north-east. The inward nine holes follow the fence line of the bordering croft land, with out of bounds to concentrate the mind. Of the two short holes, the delightful 13th, Snake, winds back towards the sea, whilst the 18th contains all the concerns of protecting a score against a bunkered green a two hundred yard carry away and under the scrutiny of the clubhouse windows.

TUESDAY 8/9/26 – PLAY CASTLESTUART

The Castle Stuart course, opened in Summer 2009, has been created by the same team behind the excellent Kingsbarns Links near St Andrews. Castle Stuart is in a superb setting on the Moray Firth to the east of Inverness. Golfers will enjoy superb views across the Moray Firth from all around the links. The course design has been given very careful consideration and the layout ensures each hole is isolated from the others.



While the course features revetted bunkers, much associated with Scottish links golf, the designers have included large open bunkers which are more in keeping with the original links when large open sandy areas were common features of the golf courses. Undulating links terrain and these large open bunkers will provide plenty of challenge and entertainment for visitors to this new golfing venue.



On the drive back to Dornoch you will stop for a tour (& a sampling!) at the Glenmorangie Distillery in the Village of Tain.

WEDNESDAY 9/9/26 – OPTIONAL GOLF AT GOLSPIE & TRAVEL TO TROON ON THE AYRSHIRE COAST

There will be an optional early morning round at Golspie for those that want another, final taste of Highlands golf! "Authenticity. Beauty. Challenge." At Golspie, you get it all. A varied and challenging course, the most spectacular views in Scotland, and the friendliest of Highland welcomes. With a design influenced by the great James Braid, this 6021-yard course embodies the true spirit of Scottish golf. Breath-taking views to both sea and mountains make it a delight to play for all abilities. But it's also a course where links holes lead to heathland with unforgettable pin placements and bunkering throughout. Situated on the North Coast 500 route, come and find out all that makes Golspie Golf Club that extra bit special. "If you come to the Highlands, Golspie has to be on your list of places to play."



Then, today is our first moving day. Pack up, load the coach & wave goodbye to the Scottish Highlands. We can take our time on the drive south & consider stops at some famous highlands landmarks or even Loch Ness. We drive through Glasgow as we continue south & check into the wonderful destination hotel right beside Royal Troon Golf Club, The Marine!

THURSDAY 10/9/26 – PLAY ROYAL TROON

Royal Troon is home to one of the best links courses on the west side of Scotland and is steeped in golfing history – notably the several dramatic Open Championships held there since the first in 1923. It is regarded as one of the sternest tests on the Open Rota. The course is perhaps most famous for the tiny 8th hole, "The Postage Stamp", and for being home to both the longest, and shortest, holes in Open golf. The course was designed by the combined expertise of Braid, MacKenzie and Pennick- it is undulating in the classic links fashion with danger lurking in the guise of wind, rough and bunkers.



Maybe you should be comforted by the fact that an Aussie (Greg Norman) holds the course record? However, you just need to remember to avoid the drive bunker on the right of the 18th fairway- if he did he'd have at least 1 more Major to his name!

FRIDAY 11/9/26 – PLAY PRESTWICK

Prestwick Golf Club was founded in 1851 and Old Tom Morris was summoned from St Andrews to be Keeper of the Green as well as Club and Ball Maker. The first Open Championship was held here in 1860- it was won by Willie Park of Musselburgh with a score of 174 for 36 holes. When Young Tom Morris won for the third successive time in 1870 he started with a three on the Par 6 (!!) 578 yard 1st hole. The hole is a little shorter now but 3 is still a great score with the railway line staring you in the face. The Open was played at Prestwick 25 times - the last being in 1925. Then, as now, it was considered too short, too gimmicky, too old fashioned and too confined to continue on the Rota.



Prestwick however, continues to be an exhilarating journey. There are towering sand hills, fairways out of a moonscape, hidden greens cunningly defended by humps and hollows, two of the world's most storied blind holes and one of the world's most spectacular bunkers - all sited on fairways and greens of the truest seaside turf.

SATURDAY 12/9/26 – PLAY TURNBERRY AILSA COURSE

Ailsa has shaped some of the most remarkable moments in golf's history. Its first three holes pose a fairly tough opening, particularly when the wind blows from the Ailsa Craig. The scenery is magnificent & the course demanding. Commanding stout hitting, the 5th to the 8th are framed by sandy hillocks, while the 9th-11th



are flanked by craggy rocks. On the edge of the sea, the 9th hole is Turnberry's trademark. The landmark lighthouse casts shadows over the 13th-century ruins of Bruce's Castle, the reputed birthplace of Scotland's hero king Robert the Bruce, and the narrow path to the tee and the drive across the corner of the bay fill players with trepidation.

The back nine requires both cleverness and control. The steep incline of the plateau green on the 13th hole—Tickly Tap or "Tricky Little Stroke"—makes one of the largest putting surfaces on the course look rather small. Likewise, the subtle contours of the 17th hole, Lang Whang, slightly obstruct each shot. On the 18th, with the red-roofed hotel in sight to distract, gorse running down the right side and small dunes peeking up just enough to block your view of the landing zone, finding the fairway is even more difficult.

SUNDAY 13/9/26 – TRAVEL TO NORTH BERWICK

It's a special day. Check out, load up & all aboard for St Andrews, the Home of Golf! We make a short detour on our way to North Berwick to stop off in St Andrews. We will have time for lunch, a drink, some shopping & a walk around The Old Course! The old girl is closed on Sundays....you can walk around at leisure but make sure you dodge the locals exercising their dog, having a picnic or just relaxing on the links! Then it's off for the last stop on our tour....the great golfing village of North Berwick!

MONDAY 14/9/26 – PLAY DUNBAR

The course lies on land where Oliver Cromwell's army camped prior to the Battle of Dunbar in 1650 and it is known that golf was played in this area at least as early as the beginning of the 17th Century. Dunbar is laid out on a narrow stretch of land (just 25 meters wide on the 16th!) which follows the natural contours of the coastline. The main features include the Old Deer Park Wall running the length of the course, Barns Ness Lighthouse at the 9th and the ruined building known as "The Vaults" at the 14th green. Slicers will visit the rocky beach more than once on the closing stretch.



The course has hosted many tournaments including the Scottish Amateur, Professional and Boys Championships. It is also used regularly as a British Open qualifying site when the tournament proper is contested at Muirfield. Renowned golf writer James Finegan comments: "It's not easy to call up any stretch of holes with lovelier views than those of Dunbar".

TUESDAY 15/9/26 – PLAY MUIRFIELD

There are no signposts from the roadway to the H.C.E.G (The Honourable Company of Edinburgh Golfers...r Muirfield) as we head from Gullane to North Berwick – but your driver will know which tiny laneway to take. 15 Opens have been contested over this majestic links and the list of winners is impressive – Player, Trevino, Watson, Faldo and, from an earlier time, Vardon, Braid, Hagen and Cotton. Nicklaus was so impressed he named his home course in Ohio, “Muirfield Village”. The most recent Muirfield Open saw Ernie Els defeat Aussie hopes, Stuart Appleby and Steve Elkington, in a playoff. It was also the only time I can remember Tiger shooting in the 80's.



The club is often considered Scotland's “least welcoming” - of visitors in general and ladies in particular. However, ladies ARE allowed to play the course (!), if not enter the main parts of the imposing clubhouse. These idiosyncrasies are easily overlooked once you step out on the course which is regarded by many of the game's top players as being the “fairest” on the Rota of courses used by the R&A for the Open Championship. One of its unusual charms is that it is laid out in two separate loops, the front nine running clockwise on the outer and the back nine going in the opposite direction on the inner.

WEDNESDAY 16/9/26 - EXPLORE EDINBURGH OR OPTIONAL ROUND AT ARCHERFIELD LINKS

History buffs are spoiled for choice when it comes to finding things to do in Edinburgh. Start your adventure on the historic Royal Mile, connecting the imposing Edinburgh Castle and majestic Palace of Holyrood House, an official Royal residence. Inside each, you can learn more about the history of Scotland, the monarchy, and the role Edinburgh played in shaping modern Scotland. Visitors can also use their holidays in Scotland to soak up some of the art and literature that makes Edinburgh famous around the world. Things to do include a visit to the National Portrait Gallery or the National Museum of Scotland, both newly refurbished and offering wonder for visitors of all ages.



Of course, there is an option for those that want more golf.... Archerfield (Fidra Links)!



Archerfield is a magnificent estate developed between Gullane and North Berwick in a very picturesque part of East Lothian. It offers magnificent views of Fidra Island and the Fife coastline. Set on five hundred acres with an exclusive club, it offers an experience quite unlike any other in Scotland. Golf has been played in this part of Scotland for centuries and the original six-hole course that existed here was extended to thirteen holes in 1869. This 13-hole course of Archerfield House was extended to eighteen holes around 1910 with help from North Berwick professional, Ben Sayers. Unfortunately with the outbreak of World War II the estate was taken over by the army and fell into a state of disuse for over fifty years. The estate has now been redeveloped to make place for two outstanding golf courses. Archerfield House has been beautifully restored and a luxurious clubhouse created. The courses, the Fidra and the Dirleton have been designed by David J. Russell who has taken the natural elements into consideration.

Fidra was created first and is an inviting blend of pine forests and inviting fast paced Scottish links. It lies between the 8th hole of Muirfield and ninth hole of North Berwick In such exalted company a new course must meet their exacting standards. The greens are wide and receptive but tricky with subtle burrows in their contouring. The early holes are secluded from the rest by pines. The links aspect of the course is obvious after the 12th hole. The course meanders towards the beach and offers commanding views of the Bass Rock, Firth of Forth and the coast of Fife. Several of the greens at Archerfield Golf Club are tucked away in secluded corners and the contrasting terrain offers a challenge for all levels of golfers on this links course.

THURSDAY 17/9/26 – PLAY GULLANE #1

Gullane Golf Club in East Lothian, Scotland offers championship quality links golf courses with dramatic views across the Firth of Forth to Edinburgh and Fife. The three golf courses do not have names but simply numbers which reflect their age. Gullane No. 1 has a long history of hosting international Championship golf events and is an Open Championship Qualifying course. The No. 1 Course will be hosting local final qualifying for the Open in 2013 when the Championship is played at Muirfield.



The 18 holes of Gullane No.1 Course were established in 1884. The well-maintained greens, links grasses, numerous bunkers and sea breezes make a unique challenge for the serious golfer. The 3rd was recently voted one of the top 500 holes in the world by Golf Magazine. The famous view from the highest point on the 7th tee across the course and over to Edinburgh, Fife and way beyond is worth the green fee alone. With every hole having its own distinct character, the Course is both memorable and enjoyable.

FRIDAY 18/9/26 – PLAY NORTH BERWICK

The West Links was originally 6 holes and a seventh was added before it was extended in 1877. It's not the longest course, but the trickery of the holes requires the full repertoire of shot making. A true links laid out on a raised beach, laden with brown sand forming the undulating links land 10 feet above sea level. The course has been described as from a 'Primitive Age' - a period from the beginning of the game to the invention of the gutta-percha in 1848. The West Links is of great antiquity. It has its place among a very special group of courses which evolved naturally and owe little to the hand of man.



This is a golfing experience not found anywhere else, with blind holes, drives over walls and burns, shots over the bay and bunkers deep enough for the golfer to disappear from view. Amongst other features this course is home to the original "Redan" green – one of the most copied in golf.

 - 2.1.10 "**Loss**" means any injury, loss, damage or expense (including consequential, economic loss, incidental damages, lost profits or savings or damages for disappointment), cost, delay, additional expense or inconvenience;
 - 2.1.11 "**Payment Schedule**" means the payment schedule set out in Item 4 of the Schedule & Booking Form;
 - 2.1.12 "**Privacy Regulations**" means the *Privacy Act 1988 (Cth)* and all applicable regulations that support and govern that Act;
 - 2.1.13 "**Services**" means the golf, travel and holiday tour services and products provided by GG to You in designing, arranging, coordinating, facilitating and managing, together with GG's Suppliers, the Tour;
 - 2.1.14 "**Suppliers**" means independent third-party providers that contract with GG in the provision of the Services including, but not limited to, hotels, tour operators, golf course operators, car rental companies, restaurants and other third party suppliers;
 - 2.1.15 "**Tour**" means the golf, travel and holiday tour and benefits as described in Item 5 of the Schedule & Booking Form held between the Tour Period, as that tour and those benefits may be modified by GG from time to time on notice to You;
 - 2.1.16 "**Tour Period**" means when the Tour will be held as set out in Item 1 of the Schedule & Booking Form ;
 - 2.1.17 "**Travel Documents**" include accommodation vouchers, golf club vouchers, food vouchers or any other document used by GG or a Supplier to confirm the Tour booking.
- 3.1 This Agreement is subject to and conditional on You providing GG with the following:
 - 3.1.1 the completed Schedule & Booking Form and the Agreement signed by You; and
 - 3.1.2 payment of the Deposit;and GG's subsequent confirmation in writing that your booking of the Tour is confirmed.
- 4.1 You acknowledge that:
 - 4.1.1 to the extent permitted by law, GG has no control over, or Liability for, any element of the Services or other services provided by Suppliers in provision of the Services;
 - 4.1.2 in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the Tour is subject to change or cancellation without prior notice (including any change for the delivery of the Services by GG or any of the Suppliers) including changes to the Costs; and
 - 4.1.3 in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the nature, standard and availability of the Services may change at any time.
- 4.2 Before signing this Agreement and booking the Tour, You acknowledge that you have read and understood the Agreement.
- 5.1 Unless otherwise stated, all prices listed in this Agreement are in Australian Dollars (AUD).
- 5.2 Any verbal quotations You may receive will be deemed as estimations only.
- 5.3 You agree to pay the Cost of the Tour to GG in accordance with Item 2 and the Payment Schedule set out in Item 4 of the Schedule & Booking Form and subject to any changes as set out in this Agreement.
- 5.4 The matters outlined in Item 6 of the Schedule & Booking Form are specifically excluded from the Tour. The list of exclusions is not exhaustive and GG reserves the right to modify the list of exclusions provided on notice to You from time to time.
- 5.5 The provision of the Services is not secured until the Cost has been paid and Travel Documents have been issued by GG and its Suppliers for the Tour.
- 5.6 The following additional charges may apply and be charged by GG to You for certain types of payments when paying the Cost, as follows:

- 5.5.1 Credit card surcharges;
 - 5.5.2 Debit card surcharges; and
 - 5.5.3 PayPal fees.
- 6.1 The Cost is based on present market prices in providing the Services and a minimum number of travelers booking the Tour with GG as set out in Item 7 of the Schedule & Booking Form. GG reserves the right not to proceed with the Tour if this minimum number is not achieved.
- 6.2 You agree not to make any private travel arrangements or bookings in connection with the Tour until GG first confirms in writing that the minimum number of travellers has been reached in accordance with this Agreement and that the Tour will be proceeding. Any Loss or Liability incurred by You arising out of any such arrangements or booking that you make prior to GG confirming that the Tour will be proceeding, will be borne by You in full at your own cost and expense.
- 7.1 The Cost is subject to change by GG on notice to You. Whilst all care has been taken to include the total costs of the Tour in the Cost, changes may occur by reason of matters that are unforeseen by and outside the control of GG which increase the cost of the Services. Such factors include taxes, fees, levies, surcharges imposed by Suppliers, changes due to peak demand periods and seasons, adverse exchange rate currency fluctuations, fuel surcharges, changes made by airlines to flights, changes made by hotels to accommodation, changes made by the golf course to the dates of play at each course.
- 7.2 Should there be unforeseen changes that occur which have the effect of adjusting the Cost, GG reserves the right to:
- 7.2.1 vary the itinerary of the Tour and inform You of the changes;
 - 7.2.2 make an adjustment to the Cost to cover no more than the unforeseen change. Should the adjustment involve a higher Cost that is no more than a 10% increase in the Cost, You agree to pay the price increase on account of any such adjustment immediately on demand by GG; and / or
 - 7.2.3 facilitate and arrange for You a comparable alternative Service of a similar standard with GG or another supplier and provide a refund equivalent to the difference in cost to the comparable alternative Service with the substituted Service (if any).
- 7.3 If GG or a Supplier changes any part of its Service for reason of the unforeseen change, GG will use reasonable endeavors to notify You of the change in the Service and provided any such changes result in:
- 7.3.1 You having to pay more than 10% of the Cost;
 - 7.3.2 the Services being substantially and/or materially different from what You originally booked, such that an alternative Service of a similar standard is unable to be sourced by GG; and
 - 7.3.3 the change occurs on or before the Final Instalment date outlined in the Payment Schedule, then You may cancel the booking and subject to clause 8, all monies paid by You will be refunded in full, less:
 - 7.3.4 any expenses incurred by GG and an amount equivalent to the fair value of the Services provided by GG to the point of conclusion of the cancellation, under the Agreement; and
 - 7.3.5 any fees charged by a Supplier to GG under the terms, conditions and policies of any applicable Suppliers with respect to the Services.
- 7.4 You acknowledge that:
- 7.4.1 there may be excessive delays associated with the processing of any refund either by the Supplier or GG; and
 - 7.4.2 there may be a change in the exchange rate of a foreign currency between the time that a booking is made by You and the time that a refund is ultimately provided by a Supplier which has the effect of either increasing or decreasing the amount of that relevant part of a refund associated with any booking GG has made with a Supplier for the Tour.
- GG will not be responsible for any Loss or Liability incurred by You arising from any associated delay or a change in the exchange rate.
- 7.5 The Services provided by GG are subject to availability and can be withdrawn or varied by GG or its Supplier. The Tour is only confirmed once:
- 7.5.1 the conditions in clause 3 of the Agreement have been satisfied;
 - 7.5.2 all Cost has been paid in full by You; and
 - 7.5.3 the minimum number of travellers have been reached for the Tour.
- 7.6 You agree not to make or bring any Claim against GG arising from:
- 7.6.1 any adjustment in accordance with this Agreement to the amount that is payable for the Deposit or any other elements of the Cost;
 - 7.6.2 any modification in accordance with this Agreement that GG makes to the Tour and the exclusions outlined in Item 6 of the Schedule & Booking Form;
 - 7.6.3 GG's cancellation of the Tour in accordance with this Agreement, including a cancellation on the basis that the minimum number of travellers are not reached; and/or
 - 7.6.4 a change to any part of the Services provided by GG or a Supplier in accordance with this Agreement including a change to the nature and standard of any alternative Services.
- 7.7 Except as expressly provided for in the Agreement, the Deposit, the Cost and any other payments made or due to GG by You are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
- 8.1 Save for any name changes made by You to a booking as provided for in clause 8.3, any other change that has been requested by You to the Tour booking is subject to GG approval. Whilst GG will attempt to accommodate all reasonable change requests, circumstances may not allow for some changes and GG is under no obligation to accept any changes.
- 8.2 An administration fee of \$100 will apply to each change that is requested by You.

- 8.3 In the event that You wish to substitute one or more of the passengers in the Booking Form previously confirmed on the Tour and provided that the Suppliers accept the change, You agree to make payment of the following charges for each additional customer:
- 8.3.1 more than 60 days prior to the Final Instalment date outlined in the Payment Schedule: a charge of \$250 plus any applicable non-refundable payments paid to Suppliers for the Tour which prohibit transfer of such payments;
- 8.3.2 between 60-21 days prior to the Final Instalment date outlined in the Payment Schedule: a charge of \$500 plus any applicable non-refundable payments made to Suppliers of the Tour which prohibit transfers of such payments; and
- 8.3.3 less than 21 days prior to the Final Instalment date outlined in the Payment Schedule: a charge of \$1000 plus any applicable non-refundable payments made to Suppliers of the Tour which prohibit transfers of such payments.
- 8.4 Cancelled bookings may also incur Supplier fees, which can be substantial regardless of whether travel has commenced. Supplier fees may also apply where a booking is changed and when tickets or documents are re-issued. Where GG incurs any Liability for a Supplier cancellation fee for a booked Tour which You change or cancel, You agree to indemnify GG for the amount of that applicable fee. Where You seek a refund for cancellation of a booked Tour for which payment has already been made by GG to Suppliers, GG will not provide a refund to You until GG receives the total amount of any refunds due for the booked Tour from its Suppliers.
- 9.1 Despite any other provision in this Agreement and to the extent permitted by law, You acknowledge that the Cost reflects the payments owed to Suppliers and compensation to GG for the provision of Services, and a failure by You to:
- 9.1.1 make payment of any part of the Cost strictly in accordance with the Payment Schedule; or
- 9.1.2 if the Tour (or any part of a booking relating to the Tour) is cancelled by You or for any other reason, following the satisfaction of clause 3.1;
- may result in:
- 9.1.3 You forfeiting your place on the Tour;
- 9.1.4 GG charging You any reasonable costs for any Loss that GG has or will suffer or incur as a result; and/or
- 9.1.5 GG terminating the Agreement, retaining the Deposit and any other moneys paid by You to GG.
- 9.2 It is agreed that nothing in clause 9.1 shall be deemed to deprive GG of any other rights available to it arising out of any default by You of any term of this Agreement, including, but not limited to, the right of GG to sue You for any Loss that it suffers or incurs as a result of that default.
- 9.3 You shall immediately notify GG in writing if you seek to cancel any or all parts of your booking for the Tour.
- 9.4 If You select the option for "share" accommodation in the Booking Form it is your responsibility to find another booked customer for the Tour who is suitable and agreeable to sharing and to advise GG of these arrangements within 30 days of submitting their completed Booking Form. In the event that no other GG customer is advised within this time, You agree to pay, in addition, to the Cost, the applicable single supplement charge as described in Item 2 of the Schedule & Booking Form.
- 9.5 Despite any other provision in this Agreement, You have no right whatsoever to deduct from or set-off against any payment due to GG.
- 9.6 In calculating any Loss resulting from clause 9.1.2, GG will use its best efforts to mitigate the cost of any Loss that it suffers or incurs arising from the cancellation.
- 10.1 GG reserves the right to adjust the Cost should the value of the Australian Dollar decrease in relation to the currency of Australia and the destination(s) of the Tour. In those circumstances You agrees to promptly pay, as and when requested by GG, any such additional amount of the Cost which will become due as a result of any decrease in value of the Australian Dollar as referred to in Item 2 of the Schedule & Booking Form.
- 10.2 If the value of the Australian Dollar increases in relation to the currency of Australia and the destination(s) of the Tour, You will not be entitled to any refund or to make or bring any Claim in the difference between the Cost in any way due to an increase in value of the Australian Dollar.
- 11.1 You warrant and guarantee to GG that you will take out and maintain comprehensive travel and other insurances (which insure and do not exclude cover for a pandemic and government restrictions), with protection to include adequate cover for all types of Loss and Liability, including, but not limited to, loss of personal luggage/baggage and money, personal liability, accident, medical, personal injury and accident, death, loss of income, repatriation and trip cancellation expenses insurance to cover their travel arrangements.
- 11.2 You will, on booking and on the request of GG, produce evidence of the insurances referred to in clause 11.1.
- 11.3 Insurance offered by credit card companies or reciprocal medical cover agreements is often not comprehensive.
- 11.4 GG does not accept Liability for any Loss related to or caused by the risks and matters the subject of this clause 11, which You specifically agree to insure.
- 12.1 Where the Tour involves the hiring of a rental car by You, all drivers must be 25 years of age or over and under 65.
- 12.2 Where ground transportation is arranged as part of the Tour, luggage space will be provided for no more than one set of golf clubs, one standard suitcase and one small item of hand luggage per GG customer.
- 12.3 GG does not accept Liability for any Loss related to or caused by the matters the subject of this clause 12 including, but not limited to, car rental by You and any damage to baggage or any of your personal property or belongings.
- 13.1 An incorrect booking name in the Schedule & Booking Form may result in an inability to use that booking and the booking being cancelled. When completing the Schedule & Booking Form, You must enter details of each traveler correctly and according to their passport. Some Suppliers will deny service if your name varies from your GG booking and may cancel automatically if your name is amended. GG has no responsibility for any Loss arising from the incorrect entry of your name.
- 13.2 It is your responsibility to directly book and to re-confirm all flights and all your flight departure times for the Tour with the relevant airline/s prior to departure.
- 13.3 GG is unable to assist with delays to either outbound and/or inbound flights.

- 13.4 Any portion of the Tour that is not used is non-refundable.
- 14.1 Suppliers of accommodation may require an additional charge to be paid locally (e.g. a resort fee or sales/land taxes) at the time of check in or check out. Please note this amount is in addition to the Cost and will be payable by You directly to the Supplier at the time of check-in/check-out.
- 14.2 The ratings outlined in the standard of the accommodation apply to the overall quality, services and facilities of the accommodation. Within selected properties, some room categories may vary from the overall property rating. Ratings are based on evaluations by the accommodation Suppliers and are not based on industry ratings. GG does not guarantee or warrant any kind of services or level of quality offered by any accommodation Supplier.
- 15.1 You must have a valid passport for all international travel, with at least 6 months validity from the date of return. You must check that you have valid passports, visas and re-entry permits which meet the minimum requirements of immigration and other government authorities for all parts of the Tour. It is your responsibility to check this with the appropriate Embassy/Consulate of all destination countries for the Tour.
- 15.2 Any Loss or Liability incurred by GG or You as a result of such documents not meeting the requirements of those authorities will be the sole responsibility and liability of You, and You indemnify GG with respect to same.
- 15.3 You shall not be entitled to any refund of the Deposit or any part of the Cost in the event that You are not able to participate in some or all of the Tour as a result of any deficiency in your travel documents the subject of this clause 15 and / or any breach by You of this clause 15.
- 15.4 GG strongly recommends that You travel on the Tour with a handicap card at all times and accepts no responsibility or liability if You do not do so and are subsequently denied the right to play by a golf club on the Tour that requires players to have a handicap card.
- 15.5 Certain golf clubs on the Tour place maximum handicap restrictions on visitors. If your handicap is greater than 18, You shall notify GG at the earliest opportunity so that You and GG may discuss which clubs have restrictions.
- 16.1 If You request, GG will attempt to secure caddies for You at golf clubs on the Tour but makes no representation or guarantee as to the availability of such caddies.
- 16.2 If GG is able to secure a caddy for You, all caddy charges (including tipping) are additional to the Costs and such cost will be the sole responsibility of You.
- 17.1 To the extent permitted by law and subject only to any express conditions contained in this Agreement, neither GG nor any of its related bodies corporate, servants, officers, directors, agents, contractors, employees, successors, assigns and those claiming through or under GG, shall under any circumstances, other than wilful misconduct, accept any Liability in any way whatsoever to You in contract, tort or otherwise, for death, personal injury, delay or any other form of Loss sustained or incurred by You or any other party in consequence or resulting directly or indirectly by the acts, omissions or default, whether negligent or otherwise, for:
- 17.1.1 the delivery of the Services by third party Suppliers;
- 17.1.2 the supply of any element of the booking, the Services or any other services by GG;
- 17.1.3 any change in the availability of the Services or the Costs of a Supplier or GG in providing the Services;
- 17.1.4 any other act or omission of a Supplier or other third parties over whom GG have no direct control; and
- 17.1.5 any other event which is beyond GG's control or which is not preventable by reasonable diligence on the part of GG.
- 17.2 Nothing in this Agreement is intended to exclude or restrict the application of consumer guarantees under the ACL except insofar as the ACL allows for that exclusion or restriction (including, but not limited to, as allowed by section 64 of the ACL relating to recreational services, which the Services and the Tour are).
- 17.3 To the extent permitted by law and subject only to any express conditions contained in this Agreement, You release GG, its related bodies corporate, servants, officers, directors, agents, contractors, employees, successors, assigns and those claiming through or under GG, from and indemnifies those parties against any and all Claims or Liabilities in connection with any Loss made or brought by You, or any other person on behalf of You, in consequence of or resulting directly or indirectly out of the supply of the Services by the Suppliers or GG and any other matter for which liability of GG, its related bodies corporate, servants, officers, directors, agents, contractors, employees, successors, assigns and those claiming through or under GG is limited by virtue of this Agreement or may otherwise be limited at law.
- 18.1 You must ensure you are aware of any health requirements and recommended precautions relevant to your travel (including, but not limited to, COVID-19) and ensure that you carry all necessary vaccination documentation. In some cases, failure to present required vaccination documentation (eg. proof of Yellow Fever vaccination), failure to clear temperature checks and show of any symptoms of being unwell, may deny You entry into a country on the Tour. GG recommends that You consult with your local doctor, travel medical service or specialist vaccination clinic before commencing on the Tour.
- 19.1 GG is committed to protecting the personal information of You and agrees to handle the personal information of You in accordance with applicable laws under the Privacy Regulations.
- 19.2 By providing personal information to GG, You authorise GG to collect, use and Disclose (including to Suppliers in Australia and other countries) the personal information of You in accordance with the Privacy Regulations. These Suppliers will, in most cases, receive the personal information in the country in which they provide Services or in which their business is based.
- 19.3 GG will only Disclose the personal information of You to Suppliers in connection with the facilitation of the Tour and and/or to enable the performance of Services by GG and the Suppliers in accordance with their relationship.
- 19.4 Where GG Discloses the personal information of You to any party, You agree that GG will not be required to ensure that party's compliance with Privacy Regulations or otherwise be accountable for how they handle your personal information.
- 20.1 All monies paid by You to GG will be the property of GG. You agree and acknowledges that such monies will not be held by GG on trust for and on behalf of You and GG may hold such monies in any account as GG sees fit, including with its own and/or other GG customer monies.

- 21.1 All matters arising out of or in connection with this Agreement are governed by the laws applicable in the State of Victoria in Australia. By signing this Agreement, You irrevocably and unconditionally consent and submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of Victoria in all disputes and matters arising out of or in connection with the Services, and waive any right you may have to object to an action being brought in those Courts.
- 22.1 You represent and warrant to GG that:
- 22.1.1 the information provided about themselves is true, accurate, current and complete (apart from any optional items) and You will maintain and promptly update this information to keep it true, accurate and complete; and
- 22.1.2 you will make any booking in accordance with this Agreement and You will not use the Services in any way to breach any laws or defame anyone.
- 23.1 If any dispute arises between the parties to this Agreement in relation to the construction of this Agreement or any matter or thing of any nature arising under or in connection with this Agreement, that dispute shall, unless resolved within 7 days of the date on which notice of the dispute is given by a party to this Agreement, be referred for mediation to a mediator agreed by the parties within 7 days or, failing agreement, to a mediator appointed by the then President of the Law Institute of Victoria.
- 24.1 Any notice, document or demand under this Agreement will be sufficiently served or delivered if served by email transmission to the person to be served at their email address set out in the Booking Form or if served in any other manner authorised by the governing law for the service of documents.
- 25.1 In this Agreement, the term '**Force Majeure**' means any event which GG, or a Supplier, could not, even with all due care, foresee or avoid. Such events are likely to include, but not be limited to, war, threat of war, terrorist activities, civil strife, riots, industrial action, the spread of a disease, a global pandemic, natural or nuclear disaster, fire, adverse weather conditions, closure of airports or ports, government action (including government mandated restrictions) and all similar events that prevent fulfilment of obligations.
- 25.2 If GG is wholly or partly unable to carry out its obligations under this Agreement because of either:
- 25.2.1 Force Majeure; or
- 25.2.2 there are circumstances arising or prevailing that:
- 25.2.2.1 threaten public safety or order;
- 25.2.2.2 would result in risk of personal injury; and / or
- 25.2.2.3 would result in risk of damage to property;
- GG may, at its election:
- 25.2.3 give notice of the Force Majeure or other applicable event to You, including reasonable particulars of the event relied on, as soon as practicable after the event occurs; and / or
- 25.2.4 terminate the Agreement or suspend the Agreement for a period that GG chooses, acting reasonably, in the circumstances.
- 25.3 This clause 25 does not apply to any obligation of You to pay any money that remains due and payable in accordance with the Agreement.
- 25.4 If this Agreement is terminated in accordance with this clause 25, GG shall not be Liable if GG is unable to comply with its obligations under this Agreement by reason of any event the subject of this clause.
- 25.5 If this Agreement is terminated in accordance with this clause 25, all monies paid by You will be refunded in full, less those applicable amounts referred to in clause 9.1 of this Agreement, and clauses 9.5 and 9.6 will also apply.
- 26.1 Nothing in this Agreement, whether expressed or implied, shall be construed to operate to place GG and You in the relationship of a partnership or joint venture.
- 27.1 Expressions used in this Agreement and in the GST Act have the same meaning as in the GST Act. Except where this Agreement states otherwise, each amount payable under this Agreement in respect of a taxable supply is expressed as a GST exclusive amount and the recipient of the supply must, in addition to that amount and at the same time, pay to the supplier the GST payable in respect of the supply.
- 28.1 This Agreement supersedes all previous terms and conditions.
- 28.2 This Agreement may be assigned by GG without consent of You. You must not assign this Agreement without GG's prior written consent.
- 28.3 All terms of this Agreement that have application after, or are otherwise intended to apply following, termination, survive termination of this Agreement.
- 28.4 If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the validity of such provision shall not affect the other provisions of this Agreement and all provisions not affected by the invalidity shall remain in full force and effect.

- (h) Daily & overall prizes;

together with other benefits that are notified by GG from time to time.

ITEM 6 EXCLUSIONS:

All items that are expressly excluded from the Tour, which are:

- (a) Equipment rental (electric or pull trollies or carts);
- (b) Caddy fees;
- (c) Tips and gratuities (including caddy tips & driver gratuity) other than specified in Item 5;
- (d) Meals other than those specified in Item 5;
- (e) Ground transfers other than those specified in Item 5;
- (f) Transport, guide, entry fees and other costs associated with any sightseeing activities other than those specified in Item 5;
- (g) Travel Insurance;

together with all other exclusions that are notified by GG from time to time.

ITEM 7- BOOKING FORM
